



**INDONESIA BIRDING TOUR: LOMBOK EXTENSION –
RINJANI SCOPS OWL PREMIUM TOUR**

**29 AUGUST–01 SEPTEMBER 2027
10–13 JULY 2028
11–14 JULY 2029**



Rinjani Scops Owl is found only on the island of Lombok in Indonesia and is the main target of this short and relaxed-pace tour.

Overview

This short and relaxed-pace tour is an ideal way to see some fantastic birds and runs either before or after our **Indonesia Birding Tour: Bali and East Java – Bali Starling and Other Rare Regional Specials** tour, depending on the year.

This small-group Indonesian birding tour will connect with some fantastic birds, not least **Rinjani Scops Owl**, an endemic of Lombok, Indonesia and a species that was only discovered as recently as 2003 and described in 2013. It is found in a range of habitats such as degraded forest, orchards, and plantations in the lowlands of the islands, where this suitable habitat exists, and we'll be out looking for it as dusk approaches. There are several other great birds to find on Lombok, such as **Ornate Pitta**, **Wallacean (Lombok Spangled) Drongo**, and more.

We will stay in a single, very comfortable, beachside resort during our time on Lombok. The resort has beautiful gardens, swimming pool, and access to the sea. It is also located close to where we will be looking for the owl, and has good food options. It's a great place to relax for a few days and do some gentle-paced birding.

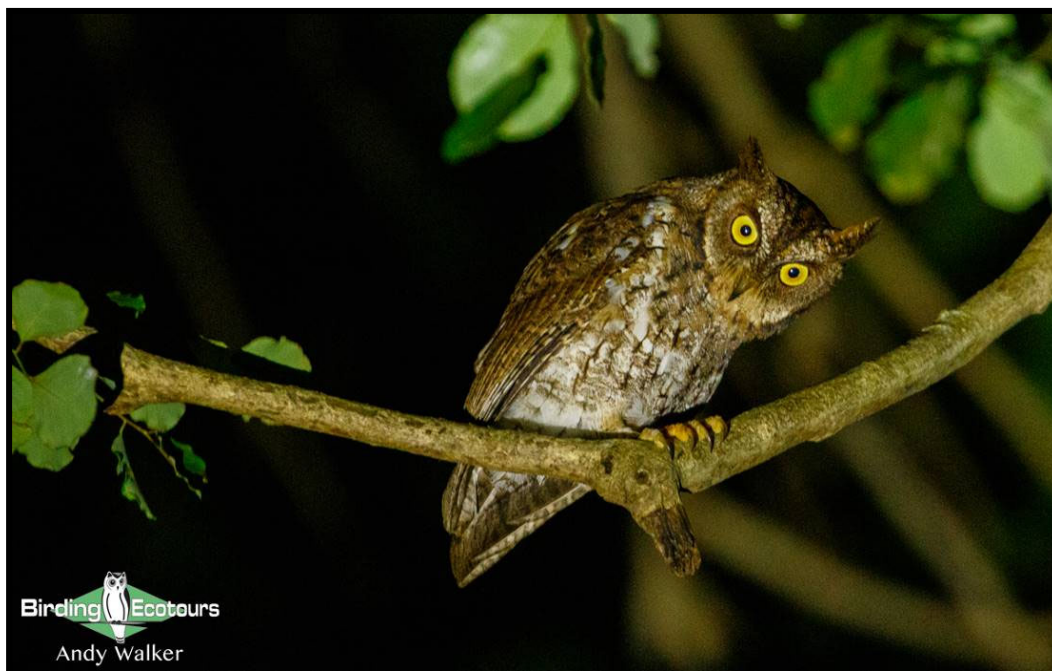
Detailed Itinerary (4 days/3 nights)

Day 1. Arrival in Lombok and transfer to Senggigi

After your arrival in Lombok (at Zainuddin Abdul Madjid Lombok International Airport) you will be transferred to our comfortable resort on the northwest coast. The day will be at your leisure

where you can relax in your room, bird the hotel grounds, or take a swim in the resort pool or sea, until just before dusk when we will gather and drive to some nearby forest to look for the main target of our trip, **Rinjani Scops Owl**. After our owling session, which might also yield **Large-tailed Nightjar**, we will return to our resort for our evening group welcome meal.

Day 2. Birding Taman Wisata Alam Kerandangan and Senggigi

We will visit Taman Wisata Alam Kerandangan for a couple of hours before we have a late breakfast. This forested area near our resort is home to **Ornate Pitta**, **Brown (Indonesian) Honeyeater**, **Scaly-crowned Honeyeater**, **Lemon-bellied White-eye**, **Blue-cheeked Flowerpecker**, **Olive-backed Tailorbird**, **Ruddy Cuckoo-Dove**, **Common Emerald Dove**, **Collared Kingfisher**, and **Cinnamon-banded Kingfisher** (if we hike high enough up the mountain).

We will spend the rest of the day at leisure relaxing in the resort grounds. Birds you may find around and from the resort may include **Black-naped Tern**, **Little Tern**, **Greater Crested Tern**, **Pacific Reef Heron**, **Sacred Kingfisher**, **Collared Kingfisher**, **Brown (Indonesian) Honeyeater**, **White-breasted Woodswallow**, **Pacific Swallow**, **Eastern Red-rumped (Striated) Swallow**, **Ornate (Olive-backed) Sunbird**, **Brown-throated Sunbird**, and **White-shouldered Triller**.

If we have still not had satisfactory views of **Rinjani Scops Owl**, we will have the chance of another go this evening.

Overnight: Senggigi

Day 3. Birding Taman Wisata Alam Gunung Tunak and Senggigi

We will make an early start this morning to reach Taman Wisata Alam Gunung Tunak for when the park opens. We are likely to hear or even see **Savanna Nightjars** along the way, particularly as we are driving through towns.

Our main target of the morning is finding the Lombok-endemic subspecies of **Wallacean Drongo**, split by some authorities as Lombok Spangled Drongo, and a bird that has probably not been seen by too many world birders. There are numerous other good birds in the park and the birding in the morning is usually great. We will also keep our eyes peeled for **Ornate Pitta** here, along with **Barred Dove**, **Scaly-crowned Honeyeater**, **Helmeted (Tenggara) Friarbird**, **Mangrove Whistler**, **Black-naped Oriole**, **Arafura Fantail**, **Black-naped Monarch**, **Lemon-bellied White-eye**, **Tenggara Hill Myna**, and **Rufous-chested Flycatcher**. We will also look out to sea here, which may result in views of frigatebirds (**Lesser Frigatebird** most likely but **Great Frigatebird** and **Christmas Frigatebird** are possibilities too) and **White-tailed Tropicbird**.

After finishing our birding in the late morning, we will drive back to our resort and we will keep our eyes peeled along the way for species like **Rainbow Bee-eater**, **Blue-tailed Bee-eater**, **Pale-headed Munia**, **Javan Munia**, and **Tawny-breasted Parrotfinch**.

The afternoon will be spent at leisure before we enjoy our final group dinner of this short tour.

Overnight: Senggigi

Day 4. Departure from Lombok where the tour concludes

A non-birding day. We will travel back to Zainuddin Abdul Madjid Lombok International Airport after breakfast, where the tour will finish in the mid-morning.

Overnight: Not included

Please note that the itinerary cannot be guaranteed as it is only a rough guide and can be changed (usually slightly) due to factors such as availability of accommodation, updated information on the state of accommodation, roads, or birding sites, the discretion of the guides, and other factors.
